

**Bromley Neighbourhood Watch Association**  
**Annual General Meeting**  
**Held at the New Life Church, Biggin Hill, TN16 3BB**  
**On Thursday, April 4 2019 at 6.00pm**

**1. Welcome and attendance**

Alf Kennedy, current Chairman, welcomed around 18 coordinators and explained that as last year the meeting was being held just before the one of the four public meetings held each year by the Safer Neighbourhood Board of the Borough of Bromley. As many coordinators attend both meetings this saves time and cost.

Four apologies had been received.

**2. Minutes of the last meeting (24<sup>th</sup> May 2018)**

The draft minutes had been circulated and posted on the website. There being no corrections their acceptance was proposed by Dave Amos and seconded by Joy Lever.

**3. Chairman's Report**

AK said that with so few on the committee we try to keep administration to a minimum. In the last year we have lost our long-standing Secretary, Aidan McCulloch; and Cheryl Mulryne who runs our email notifications is currently not at all well. We wish her well.

However we have managed to keep the Association going and are still one of the most successful Borough Associations in London. We maintain around 570 watches (by email) looking after around 32,000 homes.

**4. Treasurer's Report**

David House, Treasurer, said that there had not been a lot of movement in the account over the calendar year (which is our financial year). The balance at the end of 2017 was £2659 and a year later it was £2507. More recently we had received a grant of £1000 from Bromley Council to enable us to purchase some 700 new street signs.

The accounts were accepted unanimously.

**5. Election of Executive Committee**
